



Term Dates

Funded children and term time children return back to nursery week commencing 1st September. October half term is week commencing 26th October for funded children only.

Christmas Holiday Dates

Funded and 44 week contract children break up on Friday 18th December and return to nursery week commencing 4th January 2021.

51 week contract children break up on 24th December and return on 4th January 2021

Please can parents whose children come into funding apply for the 30-hour code for funding before the 31st December 2020. If you do not apply for the 30-hour code, you will not be able to claim the 30-hour funding from January 2021. Please ask if you need any advice or information regarding funding.

Car Park & Social Distancing

All parents and visitors to the nursery are required to park in the bottom large car park only. (Not in the drop off or pick up area, staff are currently using this area to park). This is to facilitate social distancing when collecting or dropping off your child. You will see the signage and markings on the foot path as your approach the nursery, please follow this accordingly and respect these procedures.

Collection & Drop Off

We are continuing to meet and greet our children and families at the door upon collection and drop times. This significantly reduces the amount of footfall we have through the nursery and helps us to minimise the spread of infection. We thank you for your support, patience and cooperation with this.

The staff may send you messages or other information that may not be appropriate to discuss and the front door with other parents waiting.

The old Parent Zone app will be switched off and removed from app stores on 30th August, so please ensure you download the new app soon!

Nappies and Wipes

Please ensure your child always has a supply of nappies and wipes at nursery as we do not supply these. You may wish to keep extras in your car in case our nursery supply gets low so we have some to use until you can bring more in.

Weather Appropriate Clothes and Sun Cream

At the moment, we are not offering the option for you to buy nursery sun cream, so please ensure you include a bottle of factor 50+ in your child's nursery bag so they can continue to enjoy outdoor play in sunny weather. Please also remember to pack a labelled sun hat for your child.

Malleable Activities

As you know here at the White House Nursery, we love nothing more than to provide wonderful opportunities for children to experiment, explore and develop through messy, malleable 'hands on' activities. We delight in providing a range of different materials and resources which include sand, water, play dough, cornflour to name but a few. We know how much the children gain from these materials and activities and how much they miss being able to access these and would love to be able to do so again soon. Our practitioners also miss these and ask when they can have back out in their rooms. However, in line with Government Guidance and Health and Safety good practice during the COVID-19 pandemic we removed all these resources and opportunities to adhere to guidance and ensure the health and safety of all our children and staff. We continue to review and evaluate the quidance and complete risk assessments to consider when it is safe to reinstate these opportunities. Unfortunately, having looked at options and logistics we feel in order to maintain our high standards for infection control, safeguarding and wellbeing of all the children and staff it is still too early to reintroduce these opportunities. To do so would risk the stringent good practice we have in place which has kept our children and staff well and our nurseries open and functioning. We understand this is disappointing but want to ensure we do everything we can to keep our nursery environments COVID free.
